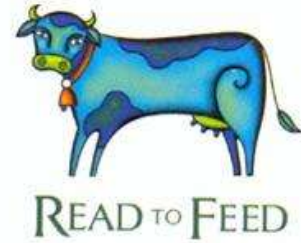


## READ TO FEED BOOK CLUB 2012



### How it works

You will need to register your child for the book club. When you register for the **Read To Feed Book Club**, your child will receive a prize incentive and a reading log.

Children can turn in a reading log sheet each week (for a total of 7 weeks). When they turn in the reading log, they will get to choose a prize from the treasure box. They will also get to put their name and the number of books they read that week on a die-cut goat that will be displayed in the Children's Room

We've set a goal of 500 books for all the children to read by the end of the program. If this goal is reached, the library will buy a goat to help a needy family. The book club ends on March 3, 2012.

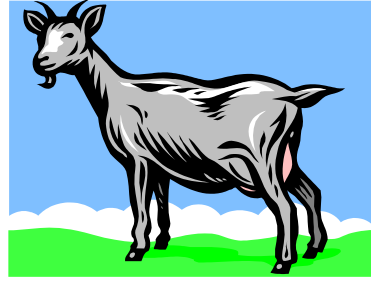
### The Idea Behind the Book Club

This book club is part of the *Heifer International's Read to Feed – Children Changing the World* program. You and your child can get more information about the program at the Heifer International website ([www.readtofeed.org](http://www.readtofeed.org)).

Heifer International is a non-profit organization that has worked towards ending world hunger for almost 60 years now. The organization has helped more than four million impoverished families move away from poverty and towards self-reliance.

Please take the time to talk to your child about ways they can help others. We are still providing incentives for the children to read books, but the ultimate goal of the **Read To Feed Book Club** is to work as a team and to help others who are in need.

Although the charity has many different farm animals to choose from, we settled on buying a goat this year. We do not know where the goat will go, but the charity group provides assistance to families in 48 countries, including the United States.



### Some Rules

- The **Read To Feed Book Club** is for children ages birth to 14 years old.
- Children must register for the book club in order to receive prizes
- Books listed on the log sheet must be read after the child registers for the book club.
- Children can only earn up to 7 prizes
- Books listed on the log sheet can be read by the child, read to the child, or listened to on CD.
- Only one prize per child per week will be awarded.
